### **Maintenance of Acid Stained Floors**

Regular maintenance is crucial to the lasting beauty of your decorative acid stained concrete floor. You will need to develop a maintenance schedule based on the type of usage your surface is exposed to. This includes:

- Sweeping and/or vacuuming: as required
- Install protective caps on all furniture legs.
- Use mats at doors to prevent dirt from abrading/eroding the surface.
- Washing, as required. Use a neutral cleaner only. Use a clean mop with clean water. Most neutral cleaners need to be diluted so follow the manufacturer's directions.
- Do not use the same mop/sponge for washing and waxing!
- The floor polish functions as a renewable wearing surface that needs to be reapplied on a regular basis. If you do not maintain the floor finish, you risk wearing through the sealer and eventually the acid stain itself exposing bare concrete!
- Applying **EZChem EZ Glow Polish**. After washing, allow the surface to dry completely. Once dry, apply 1 coat of **EZChem EZ Glow Polish** or **EZChem EZ Glow Polish Plus** using a clean, damp rayon mop. Apply in a "figure 8" fashion. Keep off the surface and allow the finish to dry for 1 hour. After allowing the finish to dry for 1 hour, now is the time to apply the additional coats. We recommend at least 2-5 coats of the floor finish depending on traffic. Do not use the same mop/sponge for washing and waxing!
- Common sense: do not drag heavy objects or furniture across the surface. Never apply tape to the surface.
