



COLOR RELEASE AGENT

HOW TO USE:

Color hardener is broadcast or spread onto freshly placed concrete. The concrete is then floated and finished. In some applications, color hardened concrete is textured with stamping mats in combination with Color Release Agent.

Note: Color Hardeners can only be applied to freshly-placed concrete before the concrete hardens. Surface appearance may vary depending on coverage rate, application technique, finishing method, weather conditions, curing and sealing method and the preparation and composition of the concrete mix materials.

COMPOSITION: Color Hardeners are a blend of powdered cement, UV resistant concentrated pigments, high strength quartz aggregates, surface conditioners and wetting agents.

COLOR & FINISHES: Color Hardeners are available in 25 standard colors. They can be used alone or two or more colors can be used in combination to create different effects or contrasting highlights. The colors are represented on the Color Chart and they provide an approximation of what the final color would be when cured with a clear sealer.

LIMITATIONS: Color Hardeners can only be applied to freshly-placed concrete before the concrete hardens. Surface appearance may vary depending on coverage rate, application technique, finishing method, weather conditions, curing and sealing method and the preparation and composition of the concrete mix materials.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT:

Obtain special instructions before use. Do not handle until all safety precautions have been read and understood. Avoid breathing dust/fume/gas/mist/vapors/spray.
